- (1) State doctoral examinations and dissertation defences are held before the members of the examination boards for the study programmes Economics and Management, respectively Economics and Management, Business Economics and Management, respectively Business Administration and Management and Systems Engineering and Informatics, respectively Systems Engineering and Informatics on **May 26, 2022 and May 27, 2022**.
- (2) Students of all doctoral study programmes who apply to take the state doctoral examination or to defend their dissertation submit their applications by **March 17**, **2022** to the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Economics of TUL to Ms. Tereza Marková (tereza.markova@tul.cz).
- (3) The following documents are attached to the application for the state doctoral examination:
 - a) statement of a supervisor in terms of recommending or not recommending a postgraduate student for the state doctoral examination,
 - b) record of the course of the colloquium within the department,
 - c) proposition of the dissertation thesis modified according to the Binding Structure available at the Faculty of Economics website (see the section on Student → Ph.D. Study Programmes → forms) in both printed and electronic version, including functional Curriculum Vitae (chronological order, no personal data),
 - d) for the actual state doctoral examination, the applicant prepares a PowerPoint presentation containing an overview of the research carried out in the area of the dissertation topic, the objectives of the dissertation, an overview of findings and achieved results, as well as an outline of the continuation of the dissertation thesis.
- (4) The following documents are attached to the application for the defence of the dissertation:
 - a) 3 copies of the dissertation thesis in the final version and modified according to both the Rector's Directive No. 5/2018 and the Binding Structure available at the Faculty of Economics website (see the section on Students→ Ph.D. Study Programmes → Forms), in both printed and electronic version,
 - b) 10 copies of presentation of the dissertation thesis modified according to the Binding Structure available at <u>the Faculty of Economics website</u> (see the section on Students → Ph.D. Study Programmes → Forms),





- c) electronic version of the presentation of the thesis (will be presented at the website of the Faculty of Economics),
- d) record of the course of the preliminary defence at the relevant department,
- e) functional Curriculum Vitae in a chronological order, including the educational stay overview,
- f) a list of publications of the postgraduate student, including the author's share and citations (responses) on postgraduate's publications, which implies meeting the minimum criteria according to the Dean's Directive No. 8/2014,
- g) statement of a supervisor in terms of recommendation or non-recommendation the postgraduate student for the dissertation thesis defence,
- h) supervisor's report (evaluation of cooperation with postgraduate student, statement on professional level of the dissertation thesis, on the Ph.D. student's publication activities and statement on plagiarism).
- (5) The next date of the state doctoral examinations and dissertation defences is planned for November 2022. The exact date will be set by the Order of the Dean.
