

**Conditions for Admission to Study at the Faculty of Economics, Technical University of Liberec  
in Bachelor, Follow up Master, and Doctoral Study Programmes  
in academic year 2020/2021 approved by the Academic Senate on 15 October 2019 pursuant to § 27 par. e) of the Higher Education Act**

**(1) Admission conditions on the basis of an entrance examination**

- a) Applicants will be admitted to study on the basis of their placement up to the appropriate capacity of the study program or specialization. The way in which the candidates are ranked for admission is based on the total score obtained in the entrance examination.
- b) If fewer admitted applicants enrol in the study, the Dean may increase the number of admitted applicants by those who were not originally admitted due to the capacity reasons; the order is given by the original admission process.

**(2) Conditions for automatic admission to study**

- a) Without the entrance examination may be admitted applicants to Bachelor study programmes who achieved a percentile of 50 and above in the test of General Study Prerequisites in the National Comparative Exams (NSZ), and at the same time who achieved a percentile of 50 and above in the English language test.
- b) Additionally, applicants who have successfully passed the state graduation examination ("maturita") in mathematics+ or with result excellent to good in mathematics can be admitted without an entrance examination.
- c) Graduates of bachelor's degree programs at the Faculty of Economics of TUL will be automatically admitted to the follow-up master's degree programs if they reach in the academic year of entrance examinations the weighted arithmetic average for the whole study without the last (summer) semester up to 1.70 or less.

**(3) Conditions for waiving the entrance examination**

- a) The entrance exam is waived for applicants who have successfully completed a bachelor's, master's or doctoral degree program in the same or related field or in the appropriate higher level of studies application.
- b) Furthermore, the entrance examination is waived for applicants to a follow-up master's degree who have simultaneously completed a study program in the Czech Republic and a study program abroad.

**(4) Conditions for admission of foreigners studying in English**

Applicants will be admitted on the basis of recognition (nostrification) of previous foreign studies according to § 48 of the Higher Education Act by the date of enrolment, and the admission interview.
